Thai-Nichi Institute of Technology hereby announces Quota Admission 1st Round for the International Program for the Academic Year 2025 will be carried out as stated below.

1. Thai-Nichi International College Programs

Digital Engineering Program (DGE)	<p><u>Quota Admission 1st Round.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The applicant must have graduated or is studying an M.6 in a Thai system school or graduated from an English Program (EP), Intensive English Program (IEP), Bilingual program, International school, or an overseas institution.- The applicant who submits GED must pass 4 subjects with a minimum total score of 600 and also provide an official high school transcript of M.4 (Grade 10) or its equivalent with at least 2 terms.- The applicant who applies with IGCSE must have IGCSE, GCSE or GCE 'O' Level with at least 5 subjects and GCE 'AS' Level or GCE 'A' Level with at least 3 subjects (8 subjects in total) with a minimum Grade of C or above. The applicant also has to submit an official high school transcript of M.4 (Grade 10) or its equivalent with at least 2 terms.- Average annual GPAX must not be lower than 2.50

2. General qualifications for all types of applicants

1. Student must have an identity card or be a person who is legally residing in Thailand
2. The applicant must be in excellent physical and mental health without any of the following

Conditions:

- leprosy, tuberculosis, lung disease, chronic alcoholism, heart problem, or drug addiction
- chronic, untreatable disease

3. Criteria for Acceptance

3.1 Quota Admission 1st Round (GPAX 4 Semesters \geq 2.50) must have one of the following qualifications:

3.1.1.1 A student or studying in M. 6, or grade 12, or year 13, or equivalent education at either The TNI School Network or other schools.

3.1.1.2 The school can submit a list of students all their majors, and applicants can choose only one faculty and one program.

3.1.1.3 Applicants must have some school engagement or community activities or have special abilities such as Japanese or other aspects that the university deems appropriate for the faculty/disciplines applying.

4. Scholarships (TNI Fund)

4.1 Quota 1st Round Admission

Exemption of **25% of tuition fee**

Considered by **Interview only**

These are bond-free scholarships with no obligation to reimburse the institution after graduation.

4.1.1 Conditions for Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients must comply with the conditions specified by the institution throughout the scholarship period as follows:

1. If recipient students' academic standing falls below the minimum required GPAX, the scholarship will be downgraded to the lower scholarship type during the next semester until the students can meet the required GPAX for that scholarship level. Please Note: Upgrading from an original to a higher scholarship type is not permitted.

2. Scholarship recipients are not allowed to change or transfer to another program or withdraw from their studies; otherwise, the scholarship will be terminated. However, students may re-apply for scholarships under the terms and conditions set by TNI. If a scholarship recipient withdraws from their studies, they must inform TNI immediately with a written notice for further scholarship consideration.

3. Scholarship will not be paid in cash or checks but will be reimbursed according to the actual course registration for each semester.

4. The scholarship will be terminated without any penalty under the following conditions:

- 1) Death

- 2) Disability or severe illness, verified by a physician
- 5. Scholarship will be terminated with a penalty under the following conditions:
 - 1) Student’s misconduct leading to TNI’s decision to terminate the scholarship
 - 2) Changing of a program or to another university without permission
 - 3) Inability to complete the degree requirements within the program period
 - 4) Withdrawal to study at or receive a scholarship from another university
 - 5) Other actions that violate TNI scholarship regulations

5. Required Application Documents

5.1.1 One copy of Thai Identification Card or passport (for international students)

5.1.2 Diploma or educational certificates:

- One copy of the most recent grade report showing at least 4 semesters
- One copy of a certificate of equivalent grade report certified by the Ministry of Education (for overseas graduation)
- One copy of IGSCCE certificate (Once you are admitted, the Office of Registrar will require an official, unopened GED test score. You may opt to send an official, unopened GED test score to Admissions who will forward to the Office of Registrar as an official test score.) or GED certificate
- Standardized English test score: TOEFL, IELTS (Academic), SAT I, or SAT II (for those submitting standardized test score)

7. Application Procedure

1. Fill the online application at <https://tnic.tni.ac.th/>, double check for accuracy before submitting.
2. Applicants must check their application's status on website(<https://reg.tni.ac.th/registrar/apphome.asp>) after sending the required documents.

8. Student registration

8.1 New student registration fee

Eligible for further study Fees must be paid for the first semester of the 2025 academic year in order to enroll new students.

Special privileges for those who register new students and pay semester fees as specified by the institute

- Quota Admission 1st Round

New student registration receives a special discount scholarship worth 7,000 baht. Special privileges only for those who have registered for new students in the quota category by 15th December 2024 only.

Pay in full or pay a portion with educational loan funds.

For students who have received a 25 % scholarships, they must choose to receive either credit exemption or a discount.

9. Tuition Fees

Those who have been selected to study must pay the registration fee, student card fee, guide fee, tuition, and credits for the first semester of the 2025 academic year, which are estimated costs listed below
